Things to do before your move

Two weeks to go:

- Mail redirection with Post Office
- Start clearing out unwanted items
- Prepare 'information folder' for new home owners to include appliance guarantees/instructions, local information, forwarding address, etc
- Confirm arrangements with your removal company (contact enfields if you need assistance with this)
- Let your phone company know you are moving

One week to go:

- Remember to defrost your fridge/freezer
- Confirm with enfields arrangements for handover of keys and burglar alarm code
- Cancel milk, newspapers, cleaners, etc
- Start packing items you will not be needing

One day to go:

- Finish packing
- Keep your car keys, cash, cheque book, credit cards and mobile phone handy
- Pack an 'essentials' box to include kettle, mugs, tea/coffee, etc

Moving day (at your old house):

- Do not pack the 'information folder' which you have prepared for your buyer
- Read your electricity, gas and water meters
- Make sure you have switched off all appliances
- Make sure you have secured all doors and windows

Moving day (at your new house):

- Read your electricity, gas and water meters and notify suppliers of readings
- Congratulate yourself on all the hard work. At last you know it was worth it!
